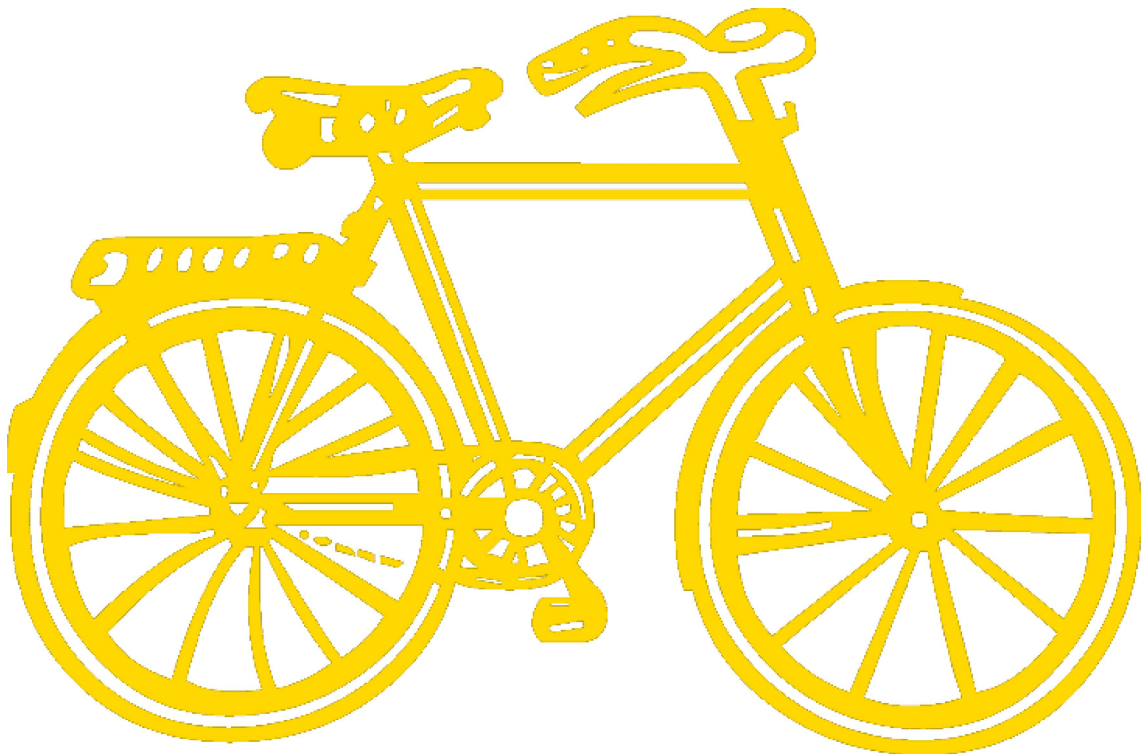


Addressing Unemployment And Food Security In Andhra Pradesh
